

LIST OF PROHIBITED ARTICLES/DANGEROUS GOODS

1. Passengers and Cabin Baggage

Without prejudice to applicable safety rules, passengers are not permitted to carry the following articles into security restricted areas and on board an aircraft.

- 1.1. Guns, firearms and other devices that discharge projectiles: devices capable, or appearing capable, of being used to cause serious injury by discharging a projectile, including:

Pistols, revolvers, rifles, shotguns, toy guns and replicas capable of being mistaken for real weapons
Compressed air and CO2 guns, Pellet guns, component parts of firearms, cross bows and arrows
Signal flare and starter pistols, harpoon and spear guns slingshots and catapults.
- 1.2. Stunning devices: devices designed specifically to stun or immobilize, including:
 - (a) Stun guns, stun batons, mace, tear gas, tasers.
 - (b) Other disabling and incapacitating gases and spray, like animal repellent, capsicum and acid sprays.
 - (c) Animal stunners and animal killers.
- 1.3. Objects with a sharp point or sharp edge, capable of being used to cause serious injury, including:
 - (a) Ice picks and axes, knives with blades of more than 6 cm.
 - (b) Razor blades, Martial arts equipment, Swords and sabres, box cutters, hatchets, bolt and nail guns, Cleavers, Scissors with blades of more than 6 cm as measured from the fulcrum.
- 1.4. Workmen's tools: tools capable of being used either to cause serious Injury or to threaten the safety of aircraft, including:
 - (a) Crowbars, Drills and Saws including cordless portable power tools.
 - (b) Blowtorches, tools with a blade or shaft of more than 6 cm.
- 1.5. Blunt instruments: objects capable of being used to cause injury when used to hit, including:

Baseball and softball bats, Clubs and batons, billy clubs, blackjacks, Night sticks, Martial arts equipment.
- 1.6. Explosives and incendiary substances and devices capable, or appearing capable, of being used to cause serious injury or to pose a threat to the safety of aircraft, including:

Ammunition, Blasting caps, detonators and fuses, replica or imitation explosive devices, Mines, grenades and other explosive military stores, Fireworks and other pyrotechnics, Smoke-generating canisters and smoke-generating cartridges, Dynamite, gunpowder, and plastic explosives.



2. Hold Baggage

Passengers are not permitted to carry the following articles in their hold baggage:

Explosives and incendiary substances and devices capable of being used to cause serious injury or to pose a threat to the safety of aircrafts, including ammunition, blasting caps, detonators and fuses, mines, grenades and other military explosives Fireworks and pyrotechnics smoke-generating canisters and smoke-generating cartridges Dynamite gunpowder, and plastic explosives.
